## WELCOME, SPRING LET'S LEARN ABOUT THE HORICON MARSH!

- The Horicon Marsh is a 33,000-acre wetland carved out by a continental glacier thousands of years ago.
- Horicon Marsh is the largest freshwater Marsh in the United States!
- There are over 5 miles of designated hiking trails through forest, prairies and wetland habitats.
- You can see Canada geese, wood duck, marsh wren, painted turtles, deer, beavers, muskrat, river otters, and mink!
- While 300 different kinds of birds have been recorded at the marsh over the year, it is home to a number of threatened and endangered species, which gives birders the occasional rare sighting.
